The Book of Nehemiah

Quick Background

- Nehemiah is the cupbearer for the king of Persia.
- He feels called by God to repair the walls in Jerusalem.
- He seeks God's guidance and God provides miraculously.
- But then opposition arises.

Nehemiah 4

- It starts to get messy. Both externally & internally.
- So, what does Nehemiah do?

Verse 13: He groups them up by families (clans)

- Hebrew word: mišpāḥâ clan, family, tribe
- And Nehemiah tells these families that it is time to get serious ("Get your armor. And get ready to fight.")

Verse 14: Nehemiah looks at these families and says...

- Do not be afraid of them
 - Don't let a messy circumstance cloud what is true.
- Remember who your God is
 - o He is great. And He is awesome.
- And fight for your family
 - o Brothers, sons, daughters, wives, homes.

How Do You Fight for Your Family?

1 – Fight to See Your Family as _____

Family is God's Idea

- Genesis 1:27-28 So God created man in his own image...
 male and female he created them. And God blessed them.
 And God said to them, 'Be fruitful and multiply.'
- **Psalm 127:3** Behold, children are a heritage from the Lord, the fruit of the womb a reward.

John Stonestreet – "Family is not a human invention, it's a divine creation. God made family before He made the church, before He made the state. Family is foundational to the way God works in the world."

Application #1 – Honest assessment: Are you seeing your family				
(spouse, kids, parents, siblings, extended family) as God does?				
What are three ways you can see God's goodness in your family?				

2 - Fight to _____ the Mess

Fighting for your family is hard

- Galatians 6:9 And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.
- **Judges 8:4** And Gideon came to the Jordan and crossed over, he and the 300 with them, exhausted yet pursuing.

Justin Whitmel Earley – "Family life is a liturgy of love and sacrifice in the midst of chaos. It's messy, it's beautiful, and it's the primary context where the gospel gets worked out in everyday life."

Tim Kimmel – "Parenting isn't about creating perfect children. It's about pointing our imperfect kids to the perfect God."

Application #2 – When it's hard, that doesn't necessarily mean you

are doing something wrong. What is something "messy" in your
family right now? Don't pull away or give up. Bring God into your
mess and trust Him with it. Maybe write "exhausted yet pursuing" or
your mirror.

Be intentional with the time you have with your family

3 – Fight to _____ Your Family

- Ephesians 5:15-16 Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time, because the days are evil.
- **Deuteronomy 6:6-7** And these words that I command you... You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.

The Four "P's": Have a *Plan*, be *Present*, be a *Parent*, be a *Passionate* Follower of Jesus (Fuel: PRAYER!)

Todd Wagner – "You don't fall into successful, intentional human development. Extraordinary homes don't just let things fall their way. I tell people, come up with something you intend to do. Start simply and simply start. Most of us have a plan for our fitness, a plan for our eating, a plan for how to develop our careers, a plan for our retirement, and we don't have a plan for the most precious stewardship in life that God has given us: the ability to give birth to and shape to eternal humanity made in the image of God."

4 – Fight for	in Your Family

Story of the Bible is filled with family strife

- Genesis 4:9 Then the Lord said to Cain, "Where is Abel your brother?" He said, "I do not know; am I my brother's keeper?"
- Genesis 50:19-20 But Joseph said to them, "Do not fear, for am I in the place of God? As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good."
- Colossians 3:13 (NIV) Bear with each other and forgive one another... forgive as the Lord forgave you.

Conclusion: What Your Family Needs Most

Matthew 16:25 – For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it.

Ephesians 3:14-19 – For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, from whom every <u>family</u> in heaven and on earth is named... so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith... and you may know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.
